90-Second Script

Introduction: 0:00 – 0:18

Summary: The host lays out the episode plans and introduces himself.

- “Decades after he last picked up a baton in a high school classroom, Dr. Robert Hansbrough's former students say the lessons he taught them still guide their lives.”
- “This summer, more than 60 former students returned to Tallahassee to honor the longtime Lincoln High School band director and thank the teacher they say helped shape who they became. “
- “I’m your host, Lloyd Harger and this is the Music Continues.”
- MUSIC: Sharp Drumline intro music plays for 5 seconds then fades down.

Background: 0:18 – 0:30

Summary: The host contextualizes the issue for listener understanding.

- “Dr. Robert Hansbrough spent 12 years leading the band program at Lincoln High School, but his students say his greatest impact extended far beyond music.”
- MUSIC: Music Fade Up 3 Seconds
- CROSSFADE: Music to Natural Sound Fade In

Interview: 0:30 – 1:18

Summary: Interview setup and the host and interview subject discuss the issue at length.

- NAT SOUND: Event ambience / reunion sound.
- HANSBROUGH: “It’s hard to talk about. It’s very touching. As you get older, you can’t choke back your emotions the way you can when you’re younger. When I see people who felt strongly enough to come to something like this, it warms an old man’s heart and brings happy tears to my eyes.”
- HANSBROUGH: “As a teacher, when you see your students become successful, that’s the whole reason you go into education. The fact that it was music—that we learned together and depended on one another—made it even more meaningful.”

Reflection/Conclusion: 1:18 – 1:30

Summary: The host finishes the episode.

- “For Dr. Hansbrough, the music may have ended—but the impact continues.”
- “I’m Lloyd Harger. This has been The Music Continues. Thank you for listening.”
- MUSIC: Music ends.
